Invoices were presented to council in printed form by accounts: General fund- \$12,250.16; Police fund- \$23,773.59; Major St.-\$82.99; Local St.- \$0; Sewer fund- \$6,042.51; Water fund- \$1,297.01for a total of \$43,446.26. Moved by Richards that the invoices as presented be approved and checks drawn for the same. Supported by Bruckner. Roll Call Vote: Aye (5) Nay (0) Absent (2) Motion carried.

Mayor has received 3 proposals for engineering services for water infrastructure and is expecting 2 additional proposals. Will discuss at next meeting.

Mayor has scheduled a meeting with SLC for Tuesday, January 24 at 10:00am to discuss the meter reading equipment and will ask Treasurer Goodin to attend.

Mayor consulted with Assessor Lew Smith about property line dispute between Grodi's and Beck and was advised that it is up to the homeowner to prove to the City how much property they own. Grodi's are getting a survey done.

Mayor has asked Mrs. Grodi to advise the City by the end of January her decision on where to locate the sidewalk in front of her house. Mrs. Grodi would like to speak with Rita Levine from MDOT as she recalls her stating that a 5' sidewalk next to the curb would be permissible.

Mayor will contact Dianne Pote with American Tower regarding the 30 year extension proposal and whether there is any guarantee as to how long the tower will remain.

Bauer brought up that American Water Resources (AWR) is offering water and sewer line insurance to Dundee residents and she wondered if the City should look into this and whether there is a possibility of revenue. Mayor will investigate AWR further.

Moved by Tollison that Council adjourn at 7:32pm. Supported by Bruckner. Aye (5) Nay (0) Absent (2) Motion carried.
