A Regular Meeting of the Council for the City of Petersburg was held on the above date. The Meeting was called to order by the Mayor James Holeman.

Minutes of the last meeting were presented to Council in printed form as recorded.

Moved by Degner, that the minutes of the previous meeting, 12/20/10 be approved as presented. Supported by LaRocca. Aye (6) Nay (0) Motion carried.

Representing Volunteer Energy, James Young presented a cost savings program on gas utilities. There is no termination fee if you enter into an agreement and wish to cancel.

Moved by Bauer that the city enters into an agreement with Volunteer Energy as our natural gas supplier. She also recommended that Council review it in six months. Supported by Larocca. Roll Call Vote: Aye (6) Nay (0) Absent (0). Motion carried.

Dawn Cilley clarified what has been billed and paid to Carlise Wortman pertaining to the Zoning Ordinance book. The job will be finished upon completion of the zoning map. Mayor Holeman stated at that point, it will be considered a job well done.

The Mayor reported that there were problems with the police vehicle. He became aware that the county utilizes Friendly Ford in Monroe. Friendly Ford was able to correct many problems and there was no charge as the vehicle is under warranty. The officer and the Mayor are pleased with the service received and will consider Friendly Ford for future repairs and services.

Mayor Holeman is meeting with MML on Wednesday, January 5th to discuss the proposed increase of 21% for health insurance and what other options may be available.

Mayor Holeman stated that AT&T will be completing an environmental test on the tower building site.

The city is looking into purchasing magnetic signs for Dan Smith's vehicle so he is identifiable as our assessor when out doing site inspections.
