**New Business:**

Moved by Bruckner to accept the recommendations of the Compensation Commission regarding elected officials pay. Board of Review will remain at \$75 per day, not to exceed 5 days. Council shall be raised to \$90 per meeting, \$2700 maximum per year, not to exceed 30 meetings. Mayor shall be raised to \$140 per meeting, \$4200 maximum, not to exceed 30 meetings per year. Supported by Tollison. Roll Call Vote. Aye: Bruckner, Cilley, Schadewald, Tollison. Nay: Bauer, Holeman. Absent: Richards. Motion carried.

Mayor reported a drop box is being installed at the sheriff substation in Petersburg for documents that need to go to sheriff's office or county clerk. Deputies will check box every 12 hours and transport contents.
