A Regular Meeting of the Council for the City of Petersburg was held on the above date.
The Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor, James W. Holeman
Councilpersons present were Charles Bruckner, Kevin Richards, Lawrence Schadewald and Joanne Tollison.
Absent: Terri Bauer and Rich Haller

Minutes of the last meeting were presented to Council in printed form as recorded.
Moved by Bruckner that the minutes of the previous meeting, 7/5/16, be approved.
Supported by Tollison. Aye (5) Nay (0) Absent (2) Motion carried.

Invoices were presented to council in printed form by accounts: General fund- \$24,921.36; Police fund- \$899.40; Major St.-\$2,000.00; Local St.- \$14,500.00; Sewer fund- \$4,737.07; Water fund- \$1,756.68 for a total of \$48,654.51.
Moved by Richards that the invoices as presented and corrected, as well as payment for police coverage on Community Days which was not included, be approved and checks drawn for the same. Supported by Tollison.
Roll Call Vote: Aye (5) Nay (0) Absent (2) Motion carried.

Moved by Bruckner to accept the resignation of Gene Bishop from Board of Review as of 7/20/16 due to health reasons and to appoint John Straub in his place. Supported by Richards. Aye (5) Nay (0) Absent (2) Motion carried.

Mayor reported that slurry sealing of local streets is almost complete. He will inspect what has been done on Tuesday and make sure the spill in DPW parking lot has been cleaned up.

Several resumes were submitted for the open DPW position. Personnel committee needs to meet to review possible candidates as soon as possible.

Mayor reported that the owner of a home on E. Elm that is being renovated approached him unhappy about paying water/sewer bill when nothing is currently hooked up to the house. Mayor explained the water debt charges, etc. and told him he would bring it to council's attention. After discussion it was decided that homeowner needs to pay the bill.

Richards met with engineers and walked the route of the "Safe Routes to School" to check preliminary things that need to be addressed, such as trees, bushes and brush trimmed.

Moved by Schadewald that Council adjourn at 7:38pm. Supported by Tollison. Aye (5) Nay (0) Absent (2) Motion carried.
